**Non-Combatant  
Evacuation Operation (NEO)  
Checklist**

**General**

In times of natural disaster, crisis or impending danger, the U.S. Government officials in Iceland may move noncombatant personnel to a position of greater relative safety (**Active duty personnel will stay behind**). Personnel to be evacuated shall be notified through command channels, public announcements (e.g. base siren), military recall, command Ombudsman, Naval Media Center (Radio/TV), Senior Resident notification, door-to-door, and unit NEO coordinators.

Evacuation will be in phases; non-combatants will be transported to the processing center as transportation becomes available. Non-combatants will remain in quarters until transportation arrives (personnel arriving at the processing center by other means will be directed to return to their quarters).

Personnel evacuating will be allowed a maximum of two suitcases per person, total weight not to exceed 70 pounds.

Advance preparation for a NEO is imperative. You should ensure that your family members are registered with your unit's NEO coordinator AND your telephone number and address are kept current. Keep your NEO packet and kit ready, stay informed, obey instructions and stay calm!

**NEO PACKET**

Documentation: To be accepted for relocation and evacuation, noncombatants must present proof of citizenship or other documentation that validates ties to the United States. For other countries authorized by the U.S. plan, noncombatants must show a clear tie to their parent country. Any of the following is sufficient:

- Passport
- Military or U.S. government identification card (U.S., DOD or government family members).
- Birth Certificates, marriage certificates, divorce decrees.
- Naturalization Certificates, citizenship papers.
- Alien Registration Card (FMI-551).

Other Documentation: The following ensure DOD family's proper safehaven entitlements and process through the repatriation center expeditiously.

- DD Form 2585- Repatriation Processing Center Processing Sheet
- DD Form 1610- Request and Authorization for TDY Travel of DOD Personnel
- Copies of PCS orders-validates authorization for the sponsor and family members to be in the endangered country
- DD Form 1337 Authorization/Designation for Emergency Pay and Allowances (military members)
- DD Form 2462 Authorization/Designation for Emergency Pay and Allowances (DOD civilian employees)
- SF 171/OF-612 and latest SF50 for DOD civilian employees
- DA Form 4986 (Personal Property Record) and DD Form 1701 (Inventory of Household Goods) or other inventory of household goods. Required to validate claims should property be destroyed.
- A will and life insurance policy information
- Financial records (credit cards, checkbooks, bank statements, tax record, etc.)
- Copy of vehicle registration/title. U.S. driver's license, automobile insurance policy info
- Duplicate address book.

Parents who remain behind but whose children are under 18 must have a Family Care Plan and specific powers of attorney for other adult noncombatants to escort their children to safehaven and turn them over to designated guardian. Take school records, transcripts and test scores.

- Money for emergency use

Emergency supplies

- 3-day supply of lightweight, high-energy, packaged ready-to-eat food, 3-day supply of baby food/formula, Toiletries, Extra clothing, etc.

Unaccompanied children must have legal paperwork that authorizes their escort to act as such, plus guardianship papers that authorizes the transfer. Guardianship papers should address schools, medical and dental care, and possible receipt of child's benefits

**Pets (considerations):**

Prior to evacuation: Place in local kennel, send to friend or relative or humanely destroy.

If prior arrangements cannot be made, pets ***must*** be left in quarters with sufficient food/water for several days.

Locate pet carriers near front door with all health certificates and shot records.

Evacuees residing off base- Pets will NOT be allowed to enter the base with owners!

Do not bring any pets to the Joint Evacuation and Coordination Center.

**NEO Kits**

**Needed Emergency Supplies**

- Three day supply of lightweight, high-energy, non refrigerated, ready-to-eat foods
- Three day supply of baby food/formula
- Toiletries for you and children (toilet paper, soap, etc.)
- Ten-day supply of required prescription drugs. If you are currently on medication consult doctor to determine procedures for availability and issuance of medication during a contingency

**Desirable Emergency Supplies (lightweight items)**

- Backpack or large shoulder bag to carry NEO items
- Blankets (2/person) or light weight sleeping bag
- Feminine hygiene articles
- Baby articles
- First aid kit
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Small transistor radio and extra batteries
- Three day supply of comfortable clothing
- Playing cards/small games and books

**Emergency Delivery Pack (for expectant mothers - Note 2)**

- 1 infant blanket
- 1 pair of blunt scissors
- 2 diapers
- 4 12" pieces of bias tape for cord tie
- 1 sanitary belt
- 4 safety pins
- 4 sanitary napkins
- 10 4"x4" sponges (gauze pads)
- 1 small roll of 1/2" adhesive
- 1 plastic bottle of PhisoHex (5 oz)
- 1 pencil

Note 1: Married military couples and sole military parents are required by regulation to have a Family Care Plan and power of attorney for other noncombatants to serve as NEO "Loco Parentis" to escort family members under 18 years of age to the United States or designated safe haven country.

Note 2: Additional preparation for expectant mothers is of the utmost importance. Each expectant mother, from the time pregnancy is confirmed, should prepare and have ready to use, an "Emergency Delivery Pack." Consult OB/GYN personnel at the Naval Hospital Keflavik for advice and assistance in preparing the kit. The items listed in the checklist above are recommended and should be placed in a plastic wrapper and sealed with tape to keep out air and dust. Prepared in this manner, the kit will remain clean and sterile for the duration of a pregnancy.

## POLICY

### 1. OFFICIAL TELEPHONE SERVICE.

a. The local administrative telephone system is in operation 24 hours per day for authorized subscribers. Adherence to the following procedures is required in utilizing official telephone service:

(1) All base commands and major components shall appoint one person, in writing, to be their Telephone Liaison Officer (TLO). This person's name is to be forwarded to the Base Communications Office (BCO) Building 839 or by Guard Mail, Stop "22."

(2) All requests for official telephone service will be submitted on a Telephone Service Request (NCTS Form 2305/A). Requests for changes in official telephone service must be submitted and approved by the Cognizant Department Head, Officer-in-Charge, or Designated TLO of the requesting activity. Each request must have a detailed description and justification of the service required. BCO personnel will provide assistance in the planning of these systems if required. Requests for changes or additions to existing service should be planned and submitted 30 days in advance to allow for timely action upon receipt of the request by the BCO Telephone Office.

(3) Unauthorized moving of official telephone instruments is prohibited. Connection of privately owned telephones to official lines is prohibited. Only personnel acting on authority of the BCO, shall move, install or remove any official telephone or service provided by the BCO. Abuse or misuse of any telephone or service provided would constitute grounds for immediate removal of the telephone instrument or that service, and a military or criminal investigation will be conducted if necessary. Reinstatement of telephone service requires an additional installation charge and the cost of damage incurred.

(4) All telephone lines, equipment and services supplied by the BCO are unsecured. The subscriber must fulfill secure voice requirements.

(5) Authorizing officers will strictly control all official telephone calls, which originate aboard the NATO Base and outlying sites. All off-station official commercial calls may only originate from telephones with class "A" service (international and off base). Authorizing officers will be required to validate official toll calls and other long haul calls made from telephones within their cognizance. Computer read outs showing such calls will be provided each month either by diskette or paper. Validation through logging of all toll calls and verification with the monthly listing of toll calls is recognized as the best possible method. Reimbursable customers must insert accounting data for telephone reimbursement on NCTS Form 2305/A. Reimbursable telephone service for each activity requires an Inter-Service Support Agreement (ISSA) or Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).

## DEFENSE SWITCHED NETWORK (DSN)

### 1. Use of the Defense Switched Network (DSN) service will:

a. Be authorized for:

(1) Commands, activities and agencies that require long distance telephone communication in support of Command and Control Operations, Intelligence, Logistics, Diplomatic and Administration Mission requirements.

(2) Official communications

b. Be restricted to:

(1) Only those calls that are essential, requiring timeliness that cannot be obtained by other means.

(2) The minimum time required accomplishing the official transaction, and normally less than a 5-minute duration.

## POLICY

### PRIVATE TELEPHONE SERVICE

1. Application for class "B" Residential telephone service should be made at the Telephone Office (Bldg. 839) by the person desiring service.
2. Standard table top or wall mount telephone(s) may be purchased (on non-refundable basis) when applying for service. A wider variety is offered at the NEX.
3. Applications will be made on NCTS Form 2305, available at the Telephone Office.
4. The following charges may apply to an account:
  - a. Installation:
    - BEQ/BOQ: \$25.00
    - Housing: \$25.00
  - b. Service Charge:
    - BEQ/BOQ: \$34.68 per month (prorated)
    - Housing: \$34.68 per month (prorated)
  - c. Call Waiting: \$1.00 (per month)
  - d. Unofficial Authorization Code: \$5.00 installation fee.
  - e. Trouble/Service Calls: No charge. Only the account holder has the authority to request status of, changes to, or disconnection of service.
  - f. Credit will be given only to those account holders who have experienced, at a minimum, seven consecutive calendar days of degraded or a complete loss of telephone service and who have made a telephone trouble call.
5. Subscribers desiring an additional modular jack in their private quarters shall fill out a work request. Customers shall be informed that no more than three extensions should be connected to a telephone line at any given time. Use of more than three may result in a loss of calls, due to overload of the ringing equipment in the base telephone switch.

## TELEPHONE BILLING and PAYMENT PROCEDURES

### POLICY

1. Application on NCTS FORM 2305 for Class "B" (private/unofficial) telephone service can be made at the Base Communications Office (BCO) by the military member desiring service. NCTS Form 2305 may be obtained at the Telephone Office or from your command or component Telephone Liaison Officer (TLO). This form can be returned to the BCO or faxed to extension 2929. Only the account holder has the authority to request status of, changes to, or disconnection of service. The account holder will be entirely responsible for all charges registered against the account. Toll rate charges are based on rates set by the local carrier, Post and Telcom Iceland.
2. Only BCO maintenance personnel shall relocate, repair or remove any fixed telephone installation or associated equipment on NAS Keflavik.
3. Telephone bills are mailed by the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month and payment in full is due BY COB the last day of the month that is received. Accounts not settled at that time become delinquent. Service will be terminated thereafter, and that account will be closed without further notification to the account holder. If the account remains unsettled for a further week after disconnection, a DD Form-139 (Pay Adjustment Authorization Form) requesting deduction of pay for all outstanding debts on the account will be forwarded to PSD for Navy personnel and AFI Finance for Air Force personnel. All outstanding debts must be paid in full, up to the date of disconnection, before reinstating service. Also, a letter or a request chit signed by the account holder's Commanding Officer recommending further phone service is required before full service is reinstated. Account holders will incur a \$25.00 re-installation fee. Any account holder whose service is terminated three times will be required to place a deposit equal to the highest bill prior to service re-installation. When cumulative

toll calls reach the \$1,000.00 ceiling, long distance service will be terminated. Checks with insufficient funds causing an account to go delinquent will result in immediate loss of service. To reinstall service, the bill must be paid up to date. Questions concerning billing can be answered by the Telephone Office at extension 4500.

4. All payments for telephone service must be made at the NCTS BCO, Building 839, or mailed to: NCTS, Base Communications Office, Box 56. Payment can be made by check, money order, or major credit card. If a check is returned due to insufficient funds three times for any account holder, telephone service will be terminated and not reinstated without a request chit from the account holder's Commanding Officer recommending further phone service is required. Proper use of local mailing procedures will ensure timely receipt of payment. The use of guard mail is prohibited.

5. It is recommended that no more than three extensions be connected to a telephone line in quarters at any given time. Use of more than three extensions may result in loss of calls due to the overloading of ringing equipment at the telephone switch.

6. 1-800 numbers are not toll free calls since they originate outside the USA. International agreements require that overseas charges apply.

### **Checkout Procedures**

1. Customers are to notify the BCO at least one working day prior to desire disconnection date. The office personnel will ask for the account holder's name, telephone number and password. If the account holder cannot provide a password for their account, they are required to submit a signed request for disconnection at the Telephone Office.

2. Only money orders, cashiers checks, bank drafts or major credit cards will be accepted for final payment. Customers are required to bring one copy of their Permanent Change of Station (PCS) orders, the command's check out sheet and any telephone equipment signed out from the BCO in order to close the account. Checkout procedures can be completed at the Telephone Office during normal office hours or on Thursday afternoons during the base One-Stop Checkout process.

### **Types of approved cordless telephones for use in iceland**

"Cordless Telephones" for use in Iceland, must be approved by the Icelandic Government Communication's Agency (USA FCC equivalent) and conform to the European Union (EU) Standards. Unapproved cordless telephones may cause damage to the main telephone switch, and operate on frequencies that are not authorized for use in Iceland. Only cordless telephones that conform to EU standards and bear the "CE" standard marking of approval are authorized for use in Iceland. For clarification on approved type cordless telephones dial #0-510-1500 or the trouble desk at #145.




